Don't Forget to Check Your Dust Boots

It is necessary to ensure to check the dust boots on your steering and suspension parts at regular intervals. Dust boots are key in ensuring grease is retained and work as a barrier to contaminants such as dust, dirt, mud and water. Damaged dust boots will allow for grease to escape and contaminants to enter the joint. This kind of contamination leads to excessive wear, premature rusting and eventual failure.

Roadsafe dust boots are manufactured to stringent quality requirements. Roadsafe seek to ensure their rubber dust boots are manufactured from CR material – Chloropene Rubber. CR material is treated for high ozone and weather resistance, low flammability, and high oil, fuel and chemical tolerance, offering greater resistance to contaminants and increased longevity.
