**DO NOT** attach VFPS to the vehicle using any fixing points not intended for this purpose.

**DO NOT** use this product on any other vehicle make or model, other than those specified.

**DO NOT** remove the warning labels or Rhino 4x4 logo from the VFPS.

**DO NOT** modify the VFPS in any way.

Note: Ensure no pipes or cables contact the bar or moving parts. Ensure all pipes or cables are well insulated and fastened appropriately.

- 1. Remove front bumper bar, grill and bumper bar iron
- 2. Remove the cooler pipe bracket and discard



3. Relocate cooler pipe higher as per photo so that winch cradle can be located into position



- 4. Locate winch cradle and bumper assembly and fasten using existing fasteners on front of chassis.
- 5. Then locate and fasten the side plates using M10 and M12 bolts in side of chassis as per photos



6. Locate and fasten light mounting bar using supplied M10 bolts into top of bar



- 7. Locate and fasten bash plate using three bolts in front and fasteners at rear.
- 8. Wheel arch liners will need to be trimmed and cable tied
- 9. Your kit includes a universal washer bottle. You can choose to install this in a location under bonnet that is free from accessories. Some choose to continue using existing washer bottle and paint black for visual aesthetics.
- 10. Plug in fog lights to existing wiring where optioned
